Treasurer's Report : 6-10-2021

Well this year's Treasurer's Report will, I think, be the shortest on record!

The Accounts, have been signed off by the Lady Captain.

Due to Covid, etc this year's golf season did run into early October, so the figures will include an October spend.

Our Bank balance as at 1st October 2020, was £276.78.

From January to May this year, our spend of £105, was for some of our unfortunate ladies who suffered injuries/operations. (Namely, Annette, Fiona, Anne and Kim).

The good news was that in August, we were finally able to pay out the £50 we had aside for a 'hole-in-one'. Congratulations again to Zoe Norton, who achieved this on the 17th.

Our Ladies Open raffle was very successful, and we collected a total of £221 for our funds. This gave us a Total of £497.78 in the Bank. From that we gave Mary Griffith a M&S gift voucher, for the beautiful flower arrangement, which adorned the Trophy table. We also purchased the tin of sweets for the registration table.

On 6th October, we paid out £20, for hospitality with the Edinburgh University Girls Friendly match.

We now currently have **£298.79** in the Bank.
