BYELAWS

1. The Rules of Golf, as they may from time to time be fixed by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, shall be the rules of play in all competitions, except in so far as these may be modified by any local rules made by the Council.
2. The Club Fixtures for each golfing year shall be arranged by the Council at the beginning of the golfing year and notice thereof given to each member of The Club. The Council shall nevertheless have power to arrange other Club competitions in the course of the year.
3. The order of commencing play in competitions shall be regulated by ballot or by placing of names on the Starting Sheet.
4. In all competitions played under medal rules players names must be registered before commencing play Failure to comply with his byelaw shall result in disqualification.
5. In Medal, Stableford and Bogey competitions over 18-holes, any ties shall be decided on the final 9, 3 and 1 hole and if there is still a tie, then the same format shall be applied to the first half of the Course.
6. Competitors in all competitions shall have precedence of starting at the first teeing ground and shall be entitled to pass, in the course of the round, all players not playing in the competition
7. In the event of any player causing undue delay, either in playing the game or otherwise, so that the hole in advance of that to which they are playing is entirely unoccupied, the players behind shall be entitled to pass such players, who shall be bound to permit this on being so required.
8. Members shall be entitled to introduce guests to play the Course, subject to the following exceptions and conditions:
 - (a) The charges for introducing guests shall be as stated in the current Tariff of Charges.
 - (b) There shall be no limit to the number of guests a member may introduce, except that no individual guest shall be introduced by any member more often than once in any calendar month, unless by permission of an official of The Club.
 - (c) The member shall ensure that the appropriate guest ticket is purchased and displayed.
 - (d) On Saturday and Sunday Competition days visitors can be introduced to play the Course after the last Competition starting time.
 - (e) The member introducing a guest shall be responsible for the guest's conduct.
 - (f) The Council may temporarily withdraw from any member the privilege of introducing guests.
9. No Member shall take or permit to be taken from the Clubhouse any article belonging to The Club.
10. No notices or documents of any kind shall be placed on the Club noticeboards except by the authority of the Council/Captain/ Secretary.
11. No dogs or other animals shall be taken into any area of the Clubhouse. Dogs are permitted on the Course subject to the dog being kept under control at all times and the removing of any dog fouling from the Course.
12. No person may practice on the Course except in certain places as defined by the club, and such places shall be prominently marked.
13. The Clubhouse shall be open at such times and on such conditions as may be prescribed from

time to time by Swanston Golf Ltd.

14. No golfing equipment shall be stored within the Clubhouse premises other than in the locker rooms or trolley store until time of collection. Golf trolleys and any other golfing equipment which cannot be stored in the member's locker must not be left in the locker/changing rooms when the member is no longer at the Club.
15. Honorary Memberships
Eligibility for Honorary membership of Swanston New Golf Club
Any member aged 18 and over who has represented Scotland at golf by inclusion in any team selected by Scottish Golf Ltd.
Any member with a combined age +years-of-consecutive-adult-membership greater than or equal to 100.
The Council will consider each case and present to the members at the following AGM for approval.
